WHAT LESSONS DO WE TEACH DAY BY DAY?

We have often talked about walking in the footsteps of Jesus or let Christ be seen in us, all references to the example we must be to those around us. It is a tremendous responsibility we have on our shoulders

as we think about the fact that we are teaching others every day. Not only by the words we say but the lives we live. And, it is not just our children! Everyone around us is learning something from us, even if it is but just for a brief moment of contact!

Think about these things:

1. Do they see in us one who is helpful, kind, generous, loving, friendly, and considerate? Do we seek the good of others and not ourselves? 1 Pet. 3:11; Heb. 10:24; 13:16.
2. Do they see in us the definition of a faithful Christian? Those who serve God daily, place him first within our lives, attend the services and Bible classes faithfully, and guide every step we take and every word we say by what Jesus would do or say. Phil. 2:5; 1:21; 1 Tim. 4:12
3. Do they hear from our mouths only those things which are true and which are beneficial to all around us? Bitterness, wrath, anger, contention, and evil speaking are not how we use our tongues (Eph. 4:31-5:5). Rather, do we use our words to help others go to Heaven, to lovingly correct those in sin, and encourage all around us? 2 Tim. 4:2; Gal. 6:1; Col. 4:6; Rom. 14:19

What lessons do we teach day by day? Little eyes are watching and imitating that which they see in us. Older eyes are drawing conclusions about us and our religion by what they see in us and what they hear from us.

If you were arrested today for being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?
