WHICH IS ABLE TO SAVE YOUR SOUL

The greatest question ever asked is “What must I do to be saved?” The greatest consideration of one’s life is “Where will I dwell eternally?” The greatest success of our lives is to make it to Heaven, and the greatest loss is to end up in Hell.

While we may obtain many things here upon Earth – money, position, power, prestige – none will compare with the beauties of Heaven. Therefore, it should be our every minute of every day quest to do what we must in order to make it to Heaven. Part of that will be to recognize where we are to go to find out what we need to do. What is our instruction book?

The Bible, God’s Holy Word, is a book that has withstood the test of time and every challenge placed upon it. Man has tried to say the Bible is full of contradictions and errors, but no one has ever been able to find one error or contradiction. Every piece of evidence from God’s word has been put to the test and the evidence supports that the Bible is God’s word.

When we study the Bible we find that it is the instruction book for how to get to Heaven. It’s reason for existence is to save souls. It is truly God’s power to salvation (Rom. 1:16). Notice some things about the Bible.

1 It is that by which we are born again (1 Pet. 1:23) and it endures forever (1 Pet. 1:25).

2 It is that which discerns the very inner being of man (Heb. 4:12).

3 It is that which is able to save our souls (Jas. 1:21).

It is therefore the only book we need and everything else pales in comparison to it.

Why is it then that man will continue to try to justify themselves based on their feelings, personal beliefs, traditions, creeds, and thoughts? Why do people test what they are doing by what other people think? Why does anyone appeal to their conscience as proof that they are right? Have we gone crazy?

From Gen. 1 to Rev. 22, we have the precious word of the one and only true God -- the God who loves us and desires our salvation. He gave his Son upon the cross that we might be saved and had his word penned for us that we would not be ignorant of his will.

Will man continue to ignore and reject the greatest message ever penned and trust in the uncertainties of this world? Or, will we finally get it right and “...receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls” (Jas. 1:21)?
